

Belgium Checklist to Transit in Belgium

It is essential that your file contains the following:

Documents to be provided by all visa applicants	Yes	No
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> short stay Application Form C Visa Application form correctly completed in English, picture and signature included. 		
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Two Recent Biometric Size Photograph (35mm*45mm) not older than three months with a light background (not stapled). 		
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Original Passport valid for at least 6 months, 1 copy of the relevant passport pages (data page and, if applicable, pages containing previous visas). The passport must contain at least two blank pages and must be issued within the previous 10 years. 		
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> National Saudi ID Card. 		
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Documents relating to the continuation of the journey onwards to the final destination after the intended airport transits. 		
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Copy of round-trip flight ticket. Proof of transport arrangements (Confirmed bookings of return airplane tickets). 		
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Copy of visa or travel document valid for the main destination 		

Non-Saudi applicants:

<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Copy of Iqama, valid 3 months after the intended return date from the territory of the Schengen States 		
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Exit Re-Entry visa for Saudi Arabia, still valid after the intended return date from the territory of the Schengen States

*Documents in Arabic language only are not accepted for the treatment of your visa file; only translated documents will be taken into account.
