

Belgium Checklist for Family Reunification with a Refugee/Sub

The visa application should be submitted during (12 months) following the decision of the CGRS to recognize refugee status or to grant subsidiary protection

It is essential that your file contains the following:

The original documents + 2 copies of the following documents (the originals will be returned to you).

<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Two long stay Application Forms D Visa Application form correctly completed in English, picture and signature included -For family members or group applications each individual must have a separate application form. -In case of minors (below the age of 18), the application form needs to be signed by parents or person exercising legal guardianship 		
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Two Recent Biometric Size Photograph (35mm*45mm) not older than three months with a light background (not stapled) 		
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Original Passport valid for at least 1 year, 1 copy of the relevant passport pages (data page and, if applicable, pages containing previous visas). The passport must contain at least two blank pages and must be issued within the previous 10 years 		
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Copy of identity proof of family member <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Recto/verso copy of the residence or settlement permit for foreign nationals issued to your spouse/partner or parent living in Belgium + passport copy - Passport copy 		
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Proof of relation (if spouse) <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ○ The original marriage certificate along with its translation (If necessary) in the notarized and legalized form ○ A birth certificate mentioning the name of both parents along with its translation (If necessary) in the notarized and legalized form • (if children) <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ○ A birth certificate mentioning the name of both parents along with its translation (If necessary) in the notarized and legalized form

Legalization of the documents can be submitted at Belgium Embassy in Riyadh on every Monday between 13:00 – 15:00 hrs. and the legalized documents can be collected on the following Thursday between 13:00 – 14:00 hrs.
