

## Private Visit

- Travel Medical Insurance (Get the peace of mind you need on your travels, with insurance made simple, for more [click here](#))
- Signed visa application form
- Applicant's valid passport/travel document
- Applicant's photo – 02 copies (35 \* 45 mm)
- Residence documents – valid residence permits/equivalents (in cases where applicants reside in a country that is different from the country of their nationality/citizenship)
- Proof that the applicant is a holder of (or is entitled to benefit from) a valid medical/travel insurance policy to cover Ukraine and the period of stay (the policy should provide a minimum of €30 000 or equivalent coverage) **The policy must be valid on the territory of Ukraine. If the territorial coverage of the policy is indicated as Europe/Schengen/etc. and Ukraine is not mentioned, such a policy is not acceptable.**
- Proof of sufficient funds to cover the costs of stay (e.g. Original 03 months updated Bank statements with original Bank stamp and Sign with minimum balance of USD2500, cash in Ukrainian hryvnia/other convertible currency, bank cards along with current/savings account balance statements provided the bank cards can be cashed in Ukraine, **Together with the bank statement, applicants must submit one page of their original Cheque book indicating the bank account number, bearing the bank's stamp and the signature of the responsible bank officer.**
- One of the following:
  - i) Original + Copy of notarized invitation letter from a Ukrainian citizen in Ukrainian language or a foreigner/stateless person who legally resides (temporarily or permanently) in Ukraine. Invitation should contain full surname and name(s) of the inviting person, details of his/her passport and temporary or permanent residency permit (for a foreigner or stateless person), address, and full name of the invited person, information about his/her date and place of birth, nationality, passport details, place of residence, purpose of visit, duration of intended visit to Ukraine, number of entries and place of stay in Ukraine, physical person's obligations towards possible coverage of costs related to the applicant's stay and/or departure from Ukraine; (Must mention the Travel Dates, Invitee details, Period of Stay, Single/Multiple entry).  
Document(s) confirming that the applicant is a spouse, a parent or a child of a citizen of Ukraine.  
Document(s) confirming that the applicant owns property (real estate) allocated in Ukraine.
  - ii) Certificate of a person of Ukrainian descent\* issued by Ukraine's National Committee on Persons of Ukrainian Descent. If applicant's family applies for this type of visa as well documents on their status and family relation to the applicant should also be provided.
- Copies of the inviting person's Ukrainian passport (if an inviting person is a citizen of Ukraine) or copies of the foreigner's/stateless person's passport and their Ukrainian temporary/permanent residency permit (if an inviting person is a foreigner or a stateless person).
- Copy of Travel Tickets bookings as per mentioned on Visa Application Form mentioning Name and Surname of the Applicant's.
- 02 Passport Photocopies with photocopy of previous (Ukraine, USA, UK, Schengen and Australia) visa.
- Birth Certificate if child is Minor.

Please note: Birth and Marriage Certificates need to be translated in Ukrainian language and notarized from Ukraine or Embassy of Ukraine. Translation from Indian translators is not acceptable.

*Please note that applicants might be asked for additional documents by Ukraine's visa officers (e.g. return flight tickets and other documents confirming applicants' circumstances (to be defined by Ukraine's visa officers of the relevant Embassy/Consulate General).*
