

Transit

- Travel Medical Insurance (Get the peace of mind you need on your travels, with insurance made simple, for more [click here](#))
- Signed visa application form
- Applicant's valid passport/travel document
- Applicant's photo – 02 copies (35 * 45 mm)
- Residence documents – valid residence permits/equivalents (in cases where applicants reside in a country that is different from the country of their nationality/citizenship)
- Proof that the applicant is a holder of (or is entitled to benefit from) a valid medical/travel insurance policy to cover Ukraine and the period of stay (the policy should provide a minimum of €30 000 or equivalent coverage) **The policy must be valid on the territory of Ukraine. If the territorial coverage of the policy is indicated as Europe/Schengen/etc. and Ukraine is not mentioned, such a policy is not acceptable.**
- Proof of sufficient funds to cover the costs of stay (e.g. Original 02 months updated Bank statements with original Bank stamp and Sign with minimum balance of USD2500, cash in Ukrainian hryvnia/other convertible currency, bank cards along with current/savings account balance statements provided the bank cards can be cashed in Ukraine, **Together with the bank statement, applicants must submit one page of their original Cheque book indicating the bank account number, bearing the bank's stamp and the signature of the responsible bank officer.**
- Hotel/accommodation booking, letter from the applicant's employer/sponsor confirming their coverage of applicant's expenses in Ukraine, a return/transit ticket etc), Duly Notarized Sponsorship Letter with Original Stamp and Sign
- Copy of Travel Tickets bookings as per mentioned on Visa Application Form mentioning Name and Surname of the Applicant's.
- 02 Passport Photocopies with photocopy of previous (Ukraine, USA, UK, Schengen and Australia) visa.
- One of the following:
 - i) Visa for another country (if required) and tickets.
or
 - ii) Document(s) confirming that passengers/cargo are to transit through Ukraine by car/coach.
or
 - iii) International carrier license issued by the relevant authority of a foreign state.

Please note that applicants might be asked for additional documents by Ukraine's visa officers (e.g. return flight tickets and other documents confirming applicants' circumstances (to be defined by Ukraine's visa officers of the relevant Embassy/Consulate General).
