

Study Visa Checklist

- signed visa application form;
- applicant's valid passport/travel document;
- 1 applicant's photo (35 * 45 mm);
- residence documents – valid residence permits/equivalents (in cases where applicants reside in a country that is different from the country of their nationality/citizenship);
- proof that the applicant is a holder of (or is entitled to benefit from) a valid medical/travel insurance policy to cover Ukraine and the period of stay (the policy should provide a minimum of €30 000 or equivalent coverage);
- proof of sufficient funds to cover the costs of stay (e.g. bank statement for 2 recent months, cash in Ukrainian hryvnia/other convertible currency, bank cards along with current/savings account balance statements provided the bank cards can be cashed in Ukraine, accommodation arrangements, letter from the applicant's employer/sponsor/parent confirming their coverage of applicant's expenses in Ukraine etc);
- original of the letter of invitation issued by the relevant Ukrainian university;
- original of the diploma of the previous graduation establishment and appendix with disciplines/marks apostilled and translated into Ukrainian, translation to be certified by translator with his Diploma and signature;
- Medical certificate (apostilled and translated into Ukrainian, translation to be certified by translator with his Diploma and signature);
- Birth certificate (apostilled and translated into Ukrainian, translation to be certified by translator with his Diploma and signature)

Applicants from outside India have to have documents legalized by their home country MFA.

Please note that applicants might be asked for additional documents by Ukraine's visa officers (e.g. return flight tickets and other documents confirming applicants' circumstances (to be defined by Ukraine's visa officers of the relevant Embassy/Consulate General).
