

DOCUMENTS REQUIRED FOR VISA APPLICATION AUSTRIAN NATIONAL VISA TYPE D

for a stay from 91 days up to 180 days in Austria

All documents have to be presented **in original** with translation into **German or English language**.

Required documents for all kinds of Visa D

(please file all documents in the following order):

- [application form](#) COMPLETELY filled out with ENGLISH CAPITAL LETTERS and with signature of applicant.
- 1 recent photo (with white background) with NAME of applicant on backside. Please stick to the [ICAO photo guidelines](#).
- Valid passport (max. 10 years old with at least two blank visa pages and validity at least three months after the intended return date or validity of the visa)
- COPY of passport:
 - all pages showing personal data if applicable incl. signature
 - all previous Visas issued by Schengen Countries
 - Residence Permit for Bahrain and (minimum 3 Months validity after return date)
- Copy of Bahraini CPR Card
- Print out of airline ticket reservation in English language
- proof of appropriate [travel health insurance](#) (insurance cover well over EUR 30.000,-, including guarantee to cover possible recovery and repatriation costs, as well as including COVID-19 risks; the insurance must be valid in the whole Schengen area) for the planned duration of your stay in Austria – or until the start of insurance in connexion with your employment or studies (statutory insurance). Should you already have statutory insurance, you have to prove this when applying for the visa.
- Unless excepted - Visa fees EUR 150 for persons aged 6 and above, EUR 75 for children aged below 6
- Unless excepted - Fingerprints have to be taken from persons aged 6 and above

Additionally, depending on the purpose, following documents have to be prepared:

Visa D Researcher with a valid hosting agreement

(Visa fees are waived for this purpose)

- [Hosting agreement](#) with a research institution owned to an extent of at least 50 percent by a public body or a certified research institution

Visa D for Exchange Students or Language Courses up to six months

- Proof of sufficient financial means to cover the living costs
- Proof of accommodation in Austria (booking of a room in a student hall of residence or confirmation of having accommodation)
- Proof of family ties and/or economic ties with the home country (e. g. proof of employment, proof of being a student there, spouse, children, etc.)

Visa D for Pick Up of Residence Permit Card in Austria

- Print out of E-Mail from the Embassy inviting to apply for the Visa D

Visa D for diplomats who will work for an international organisation in Vienna and their families

(Visa fees and fingerprints are waived for this purpose)

- Verbal note from the international organisation in Vienna including full name, date of birth and passport numbers of the applicant and if applicable all family members who will join and information which position the applicant will have

ATTENTION: The presentation of the above mentioned documents does not mean automatically that a visa will be issued. The Embassy reserves the right to ask for further documents and/or for a personal interview.
