Supporting documents should be in English or Croatian and shall be presented in the following order. Originals shall be presented in Visa Application Centre (VAC). Please be prepared to show original documents at the VAC, but submit only photocopies of documents. The Embassy does not return any other documents to applicant than the passport.

Valid travel document and one photocopy of it. Travel documents issued 10 years prior to the date of submitting the application are not accepted. The travel document must be valid at least three months after the completion of the journey. Travel document must contain two blank pages.			
Schengen visa ONLINE application form duly completed, printout dated and signed by the applicant.			
Recent colour passport photograph , taken within the past six (6) months, white or light background, neutral face expression.			
Valid Irish residence permit/GNIB card (Original and Copy) . Irish re-entry visa /Irish Residence permit/GNIB card, must be valid for at least one month beyond the intended departure date from the Schengen Area.			
Travel medical insurance policy must be with specified name and dates of validity covering your intended trip(s). Appropriate and valid travel medical insurance should be issued from accredited Irish insurance company and covering: <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. The expenses that might occur during an applicant's stay in the Schengen area in regard to the return to his/her homeland due to health reasons, 2. Urgent medical assistance and/or urgent hospital treatment 3. Transport costs in case of death The lowest sum insured must be of EUR 30,000.			
Proof of confirmed return ticket(s) travel ticket for airplane, bus, or boat; registration card and driver's license if travelling by car			

<p>Letter of guarantee from a legal person - from organiser/host in Croatia (proscribed form with an original or copy if the original is deposited at the Ministry of Foreign and European Affairs in Croatia; with the Letter of Guarantee, the guarantor shall enclose a proof of solvency (BON 1 or BON 2 Forms, or a or a confirmation of the Commercial Court that it is not in liquidation. OR</p> <p>Letter of invitation issued by a Croatian state authority, or the organiser of an international meeting or manifestation organized under the auspices of the Croatian Parliament, the President of the Republic of Croatia or the Government of the Republic of Croatia (copy)</p>			
<p>Invitation Letter (copy) of the organizer of the conference who is not registered as a legal person in Croatia alongside with proof of payed fees for participation.</p> <p>For the purpose of short term study: proof of enrolment from the University/Faculty in Croatia and/or letter of guarentee from Croatian host University;</p>			
<p>If the applicant is employed, he/she should attach a recent letter from the employer not older than a month (headed letter with name and position of signatory, date of issue, address, telephone number and registration number in UK) and /or payslips for the last three months.</p> <p>Self-employed should present a recent letter not older than a month from accountant, banker or solicitor, stating self-employment or business ownership in UK.</p> <p>Students should present a recent, official and signed letter from UK school, college or university, not older than a month stating date of issue, name of the applicant and type of studies, number of lessons (hours) per week and attendance record.</p>			
<p>Proof of funds: recent (last three (3) months) UK bank statements. Cash is not accepted.</p> <p>If the applicant is financially supported by his / her spouse (e.g. if the applicant does not work), also marriage certificate (Original and Copy) and the spouse's bank statement must be presented.</p> <p>Documents in relation to accommodation.</p>			

<p>Applicant(s) under 18 years: if the minor is travelling alone, with only one parent or with other people than the parents or guardians, then birth certificate and his/her both parents' or legal guardians' formal written consent to travel and copies of the passport(s) must be provided.</p>
