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Supporting documents should be in English or Croatian and shall be presented in the following order. Originals shall be presented in Visa Application Centre (VAC). Please be prepared to show original documents at the VAC, but submit only photocopies of documents. The Embassy does not return any other documents to applicant than the passport.

Valid travel document and one photocopy of it. Travel documents issued 10 years prior to the date of submitting the application are not accepted. The travel document must be valid at least three months after the completion of the journey. Travel document must contain two blank pages.			
Croatian visa ONLINE application form duly completed. The printout dated and signed by the applicant.			
Recent colour passport photograph , taken within the past six (6) months, white or light background, neutral face expression.			
Valid Irish residence permit/GNIB card (Original and Copy) . Irish re-entry visa /Irish Residence permit/GNIB card, must be valid for at least one month beyond the intended departure date from the Schengen Area.			
Proof of confirmed return ticket(s) travel ticket for airplane, bus, or boat; registration card and driver's license if travelling by car			
Travel medical insurance policy must be with specified name and dates of validity covering your intended trip(s). Appropriate and valid travel medical insurance should be issued from accredited Irish insurance company and covering: <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. The expenses that might occur during an applicant's stay in the Schengen area in regard to the return to his/her homeland due to health reasons, 2. Urgent medical assistance and/or urgent hospital treatment 3. Transport costs in case of death The lowest sum insured must be of EUR 30,000.			

<p>Letter of Guarantee by Natural Person (certified by a Public Notary in Croatia): in original or copy if the original is deposited at the Ministry of Foreign and European Affairs in Croatia; with the Letter of Guarantee the guarantor shall enclose proof of permanent source of income (pay slip, pension slip) in the last three months or adequate proof of having funds in a bank.</p>			
<p>Family members (guardians) of a minor Croatian citizen: extract from the Croatian population register and copy of the passport of the Croatian citizen.</p> <p>Family members (spouses and children) of an Croatian citizen:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Married/born in Croatia: marriage/ birth certificate • Married/born in IRISH or other country: original marriage/birth certificate • Married in non IRISH or EEA/EU country certified marriage certificate by respected country Embassy with translation (Croatian or English) <p>copy of the passport of the Croatian citizen</p>			
<p>If the applicant is employed, he/she should attach a recent letter from the employer not older than a month (headed letter with name, position of signatory, date of issue, address, telephone number and and registration number in IRISH) and /or payslips for the last three months.</p> <p>Self-employed not older than a month should present a recent letter from accountant, banker or solicitor, stating self-employment or business ownership in IRISH.</p> <p>Students not older than a month should present a recent, official and signed letter from IRISH school, college or university, stating date of issue, name of the applicant and type of studies, number of lessons (hours) per week and attendance record.</p>			
<p>Proof of funds: recent (last three (3) months) IRISH bank statements. Cash is not accepted.</p> <p>If the applicant is financially supported by his/her spouse (e.g. if the applicant does not work), also marriage certificate(Original and Copy) and the spouse's bank statement must be presented.</p>			

<p>Applicant(s) under 18 years: if the minor is travelling alone, with only one parent or with other people than the parents or guardian, then birth certificate and his/her both parents' or legal guardians' formal written consent to travel and copies of the passport(s) must be provided.</p>			
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Note: The Embassy reserves the right to request additional information/documentation and, if deemed necessary, to interview the applicant.
