

The Consulate General of Denmark in Sydney, Australia Visiting family/friends– Checklist



Dear Applicant,

Your application and documentation will be delivered to the Consulate and your case will be processed by the Danish Embassy in Bangkok, Thailand as soon as possible.

Please note that your application is incomplete if any of the document(s) marked below are missing. The Embassy therefore kindly requests that you hand in the below documentation.

Missing Document(s)	Type of document
	Cover letter completely filled on https://applyvisa.um.dk/ , printed and signed by the applicant.
	Visa Fee payment receipt printed from https://applyvisa.um.dk/
	The Original passport should be valid for at least 3 months beyond the intended duration of stay in the Schengen territory and with at least two blank page to affix the visa. The passport must have been issued within the last 10 years.
	Copy of previous visas and stamps of the applicant's old passport(s) <i>if any</i> .
	Residence Permit or other proof of re-entry permit for New Zealand valid for at least 3 months after the departure from the Schengen region (or a written explanation if you cannot document this)
	Proof of residential address in New Zealand (e.g. copy of driver licence, a utility bill, a bank statement or similar)
	If married or in a partnership, provide a marriage certificate or registered partnership agreement .
	Proof of occupation. (Payslips or letter from employer) Or confirmation of enrolment with a university or other educational establishment in New Zealand. Overseas students must provide the 'Offer of Place' or 'Certificate of Enrolment' from their education provider in New Zealand.
	Invitation Or Online Invitation ID number from the host in Denmark stating: 1. the host's relationship to the applicant, 2. the purpose and duration of the visit, 3. whether the host is covering any of the expenses for the trip and 4. whether the host is providing accommodation for the applicant. A copy of the host's passport. If the host is not a Danish citizen, please also provide a copy of the host's residence card for Denmark. (Copy of passport is <u>not required</u> if online Invitation has been made.)
	Documentation of funds to cover the trip. Bank statement in New Zealand with applicant's name covering minimum last 3 months in applicant's name According to the Danish Immigration Service you must have the necessary means to pay for your stay and return trip. As a general rule, you must have at your disposal approx. DKK 350 per day. If you are staying in a private home and your host will cover all costs. If you are staying at a hotel, the amount must be greater, approx. DKK 500 per day. You can find further information https://www.nyidanmark.dk/
	Flight reservations of return or round ticket. If applicant is traveling to several Schengen states proof of intra-Schengen flight reservation, train Itinerary or car rental. (Do not buy the ticket until a visa has been granted).
	Overseas travel medical insurance valid for all Schengen-countries. The insurance has to cover the applicant for at least 30,000 Euros or equivalent, for all risks e.g. accident, illness, medical emergency evacuation etc. The policy has to clearly specify the period of validity and has to cover the entire duration of the trip including the date of arrival & departure.
	<u>If the applicant is under 18, he/she must also submit:</u> <input type="checkbox"/> Birth certificate (original for verification + 1 copy) If you are travelling alone: <input type="checkbox"/> An original and a copy of letter of consent signed by both parents. If you are travelling with only one of your parents: <input type="checkbox"/> An original and a copy of letter of consent from the other parent. If the parent you are travelling with has single custody: <input type="checkbox"/> An original and a copy of certificate of single custody.

Note: A translation in English must be attached to any documents, where the original is not in English.

The Embassy requests you to hand in the missing/required documentation to VFS Centre **within 5 days from today**. If the missing/required documentation have not been received by this deadline, the Embassy will make a decision on the case based on the present information.

Please note that you could still be asked for additional documents and/or may be called for an interview at the Embassy.
