4	Travel medical insurance with a minimum coverage of EUR 30,000 covering your entire stay in Schengen.

6	Proof of relationship with the host. Family visit: Original notarized certificate with Apostille of family relation. Friend(s) visit: Photos or other documentation of having met the host in-person. Virtual- and/or online interactions are not considered.	
7	Employees: A sealed copy of the employer's business license and a letter from the employer (with English translation) on official letterhead, incl. stamp, signature, date, and with the following details: 1) Company's full address, telephone number, and contact person; 2) Applicant's name, position, salary, years of service, and leave approval; and 3) Name and position of the signing officer. Retirees: Proof of pension or other regular income. Students: Confirmation of enrolment with a university or other educational establishment. Unemployed adults: If married: Spouse's employment letter and income, along with a notarized marriage certificate with Apostille. If single, divorced, or widowed: Any other proof of regular income.	
8	Personal bank statements showing movements from the last three months, as well as your own name, and bank stamp. Personal bank statements are required from all applicants above 18 years old regardless of sponsorship or student status. Fixed deposit accounts are not considered. 9	Invitation letter from the host. Using the online invitation form (VU2) on newtodenmark.dk , typically reduces processing time.	
10	If host is not a Danish citizen: A copy of the host's residence permit valid for the entire duration of the applicant's intended stay is required.	
11	Minors (< 18 years old): Travelling with parents: 1) Original school letter stating school's address, contact details, and absence permission, with the name and position of signing officer; 2) Student card; and 3) A notarized certificate with Apostille confirming family relation or guardianship is also required. Travelling alone or with just one parent: 1) An original notarized certificate with Apostille granting travel permission from the non-traveling parent(s) or legal guardian(s), attested by relevant authorities if issued abroad; and 2) Sponsor's bank statements showing transactions from the past three months, stamped by the bank, are required. Fixed deposit accounts are not considered. If the sponsor is not a parent, a notarized certificate with Apostille declaring financial guarantee from the sponsor is also required.
