



DENMARK LONG TERM VISA CHECKLIST – SUBMITTING BIOMETRICS LETTER FROM DIS/SIRI

1- Letter requesting biometrics from the Danish Immigration Service (DIS) or Danish Agency for International Recruitment and Integration (SIRI)		
2- A valid passport which has at least 2 blank pages or other travel document. The passport must be valid for at least 6 months or else the permit will be granted up to three months before the expiration date of the passport.		
3- One (1) passport photo (max. 6 months old, on white background, measuring 35 x 45 mm.) .		
4- Receipt for Purchase- Receipt for Embassy fee payment from https://dys.um.dk/permit/		

BIOMETRICS SUBMISSION CASES

The applicant is responsible for submitting any documents requested in the letter from DIS/SIRI. If the applicant does not have a passport, they can still submit biometrics.

The decision-making authority in such cases is the **Danish Immigration Service (DIS)** and **Danish Agency for International Recruitment and Integration (SIRI)**
