

The application should be submitted at the local Visa Facilitation Centre VFS for Estonia.

Online completed visa application, available at <https://eelviisataotlus.vm.ee/>

As a rule, the application must be submitted to the Embassy at least 15 days before the intended journey and no earlier than six months prior to the start of the intended journey.

If all the necessary conditions are not fulfilled, the visa application will be processed based on tourism/visiting family or friends.

Missing documents may negatively affect the visa decision!

The directive 2004/38/EC shall apply to all those Union citizens who move or reside in a Member State other than that of which they are national, and to their family members who accompany or join them.			
1	Valid passport - issued within the last 10 years and with at least 3 months validity after the scheduled return, with at least two empty pages along with old passports A copy of the bio-data page of the passport is to be submitted with the application		
2	Application form – completed, signed by the applicant. If the applicant is a minor, the application must be signed by the legal guardian, accompanied by a certified birth certificate or, where applicable, documents proving custody of the minor.		
3	Recent color passport photo (measuring 35 x 45 mm) with a white background, without any software alterations		
4	Valid UAE residence permit. The permit must be valid for a minimum three months after the scheduled return Only a copy of the residence permit must be submitted with the application		
5	Proof of the EU/EEA/CH citizen’s nationality (e.g a copy of a passport)		
6	Proof of travelling together with or joining the EU/EEA/CH family member Proof of common journey: - Flight reservations including possible third countries and other Schengen countries or hotel reservation. Please do not purchase any air tickets or accommodation before receiving a visa decision and the visa is issued.		
7	Documentary evidence of family relationship Documentation proving that you are a family member (marriage certificate, certificate of registration of partnership, birth certificate or other official documentation). The documents need to be legalized or certified with an apostille certificate, if an international agreement does not foresee otherwise.		
8	Children under 18 years old, not travelling with both parents or travelling alone: - birth certificate (must be in English or Estonian); - original consent letter signed by their parents/legal guardian in front of a visa officer or duly legalized and copy of passport(s) of parents/legal guardian. The birth certificate needs to be legalized or certified with an apostille certificate, if an international agreement does not foresee otherwise
