

## Checklist for Applicants under Directive 2004/38/EC

**This category is only for EU/EEA citizen's family members who are residing in the UK and travelling to an EU Member State of which the EU citizen is NOT a national.**

**Please note that Estonian citizen's family members cannot apply under this category and will need to apply under Private (family, friends) visit etc.**

Documents issued by a foreign country must be or translated into Estonian or English and certified with an apostille or legalised. Documents issued by the UK have to be apostilled: <https://www.gov.uk/get-document-legalised>. Supporting documents shall be presented in the following order.

Originals shall be presented at Visa Application Centre (VAC), but only photocopies must be submitted. The Embassy does not return any other documents to the applicant than the passport.

Required Documents	Original	Copy	Remarks (if document is missing or if the condition does not meet requirements)
<b>Valid travel document</b> and one photocopy of it. Travel documents issued 10 years prior to the date of submitting the application are not accepted. The travel document must be valid at least three months after the completion of the journey. Travel document must contain two blank pages.			
<b>Schengen visa <a href="#">ONLINE</a> application form</b> duly completed. The printout dated and signed by the applicant.			
<b>Recent colour passport photograph</b> , taken within the past six (6) months, white or light background, neutral face expression.			
<b>A valid UK biometric residence card</b> (+ one photocopy that must be submitted) <b>and a printout of the applicant's UKVI immigration status</b> . This proof of status can be obtained through the share code generated from the UKVI account. Residency status in the UK must be valid for at least <b>one (1) month beyond</b> the intended departure from the territory of the Schengen area.			
<b>Passport or ID card copy of the family member who is an EU citizen.</b>			
<b>Marriage certificate, full birth certificate or other official documentation of family relationship</b> (certified with an apostille or legalised, see above).			
<b>Proof of travelling with or to join the EU family member</b> (free choice of proof, e.g. flight or hotel reservations, letter form the EU family member etc.).
