



SCHENGEN VISA – MEDICAL PURPOSE

This information leaflet has been generated by the German Consulate in Dubai. It is valid for visa applications in the United Arab Emirates if Germany is your **main destination**. This leaflet stipulates the legal requirements and is carried out in cooperation with VFS Global to facilitate visa applications. It can be downloaded free of charge. Applicants are requested to read it carefully and observe the regulations as stated below – see I. till IV.

Note:

Applicants for this visa purpose can apply as walk-ins (without prior online appointment) through the external service provider VFS.

I. DOCUMENTS TO BE SUBMITTED

Should NOT be older than 6 months.A frontal view of the face covering 70-80% (32-26mm) of the photo.A uniform and white background.Clear facial features and eyes – not covered by hair or glasses frame.Head coverings are only accepted for religious reasons.

Overseas medical insurance Requirements: <ul style="list-style-type: none">Valid for the entire duration of the requested visa and for all Schengen countries.Minimum coverage 30,000 € and repatriation. (Medical insurances of credit cards are <u>not</u> accepted)Conditions must be stated either on insurance document or on separate confirmation letter	
6.	Travel Itinerary including <ul style="list-style-type: none">flight reservation<u>Valid</u> (existing) hotel / accommodation booking / reservation with full address (name, street, city, zip code, contact information, booking ref.)

8.	<p>Letter from local employer / sponsor (NOL) including name, postal address and telephone number of sponsor/company , with details regarding applicant's working position, starting date of employment and salary and timeframe of work leave (expected date to resume duties) and purpose of travel. Additionally valid trade license copy for investor/partner of company. In case of dependents- copy of sponsor's valid passport and UAE residence visa to be attached to letter from sponsor.</p>	
9.	<p>Additional documents for minors below the age of 18 (if applicable) – proving legal parenthood:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Copy of either birth certificate / proof of adoption / custody decree if parents are divorced / death certificate of parent (Consulate reserves the right to request the original document at a later stage) Documents need to be translated into either German or English. <p>“Letter of consent” (Authorization of Minors) from parents, including passport copies and valid UAE residence visa copies of both parents/ legal guardian.</p>	
10.	<p>Proof of financial means of the applicant in the UAE, e.g. personal bank statements of at least the last 3 months before application, personal property, assets, others</p>	

- ❖ **NOTE:** Special rules might apply for some nationals which passports are not recognized by the German authorities. You might be requested to come personally to the Visa Section of the Consulate. The Visa processing time in such cases varies.

II. INFORMATION FOR THE APPLICANT ON TERMS AND CONDITIONS OF THE VISA PROCESS

- Applications can be filled using the online VIDEX application www.videx.diplo.de Applicants are requested to thoroughly check all entries in their written application (paper and/or the electronic "VIDEX") prior to submission.
- Responsibility for all given information lies within the applicant himself.
- Only complete applications can be accepted; non-submission of necessary documentation may lead to refusal of visa application.
- All visa fees must be paid upon submission of the above in cash (AED) only. The application, passport and visa fee will be forwarded to the German Consulate within one working day after submission. The service fee remains with VFS Global.
- The processing time at the Consulate due to necessary and obligatory legal requirements **takes up to 15 days**. Applicants are requested to apply well in advance, but – due to legal requirements - not more than 180 days prior to the intended date of journey. **Applicants are also kindly requested to refrain from status inquiries.**
- During the whole processing time the passport has to remain with the German Consulate. Passports can only be withdrawn if a written request by the applicant himself is presented to the Consulate. Consequently, the application will be cancelled / withdrawn and the passport returned via VFS Global within 2 working days.
- False or falsified documents, incl. fake bookings, will lead to the refusal of visa and /or further consequences.
- The German Consulate Dubai reserves the right to ask for additional documents and /or call applicant for an interview.**

Declaration on Travel and Health Insurance (Multiple Entry Visa Only)

With regard to my visa application dated _____ I herewith declare that according to the Schengen regulations, I will be in possession of an adequate travel health insurance valid for the complete duration of my stay(s) in Schengen- Territory.

Having been provided with the relevant information by the German Consulate in Dubai,
I hereby declare:

"The enclosed travel health insurance policy (original and copy) is proof of the required travel health insurance cover for the duration of my first stay in the Schengen area, should I be granted the visa applied for on _____ (Date of application).

Furthermore, I expressly declare that I have been informed that for every future stay in the Schengen area I must take out a travel health insurance policy which fulfils the criteria listed below and that I must always carry with me proof of insurance cover in the original for presentation on request during any border controls."

I have been informed that a proof of a travel medical insurance (insurance policy document) has to be carried along when travelling to the Schengen States.

Health Insurance Requirements:

- The validity of the Travel Health Insurance corresponds to or exceeds the duration of my intended trip to the Schengen Area
- Minimum insurance cover per person must be EUR 30,000
- The policy must be valid in all Schengen states
- The insurance company must have an office in a Schengen state, Switzerland or in Liechtenstein
- The policy must cover the cost of possible repatriation in the event of illness, urgent medical treatment and/or emergency hospital treatment.

Besides, I understand that I have to present a Travel Health Insurance according to the above mentioned specifications for all subsequent visits to the Schengen Area.

Note: In cases where the purpose of the stay is to undergo medical treatment, proof of ability to pay the cost of any treatment not covered by the abovementioned insurance policy must be provided separately.

Confirmation

I confirm that I have been informed about and have understood the following:

- Entry to Germany is currently subject to restrictions because of the pandemic. On its own, the visa issued to me does not entitle me to enter Germany.
- The visa issued to me only allows me to enter Germany if I present recognised proof upon entry that I have been fully vaccinated against the SARS-CoV-2 coronavirus (proof of vaccination).
- The conditions that this proof of vaccination must meet have been explained to me.
- I am aware in particular that I must be fully vaccinated with one or different vaccines approved by the European Medicines Agency (EMA) or with equivalents of these vaccines used in third countries.
- The proof of vaccination must be written in German, English, French, Italian or Spanish.
- Information about the exact requirements for complete vaccination and proof thereof that enables people to enter Germany despite the pandemic-related travel restrictions is available online at <https://www.bmi.bund.de/SharedDocs/faqs/EN/topics/civil-protection/coronavirus/coronavirus-faqs.html>, under point IV. Restrictions applying to air and sea travel outside of the European Union (entering Germany from a non-EU member state) and What rules apply for fully vaccinated people?
- Children under the age of 12 who are not yet vaccinated can enter the country with proof of a negative test result (PCR test or antigen test) when accompanied by at least one fully vaccinated parent. Children under the age of six do not require proof of a negative test result.
- If I am not able to present acceptable proof of vaccination, I may not enter Germany and will be turned away at the German border. Furthermore, transport companies, in particular airlines, may refuse to allow me to travel to Germany.
- If I am turned back at the border upon my arrival at a German airport, the airline will fly me back to my departure airport and can charge me for the costs incurred.
- Only when someone arrives at a German airport or border do the border police officers decide whether or not to allow them to enter Germany.

Furthermore, I confirm

- 1. that, prior to entering Germany, I will have been fully vaccinated against the SARS-CoV-2 coronavirus (as described above); and**
- 2. that I will submit acceptable proof of vaccination (as described above) on entry.**
