Disclaimer

Visa application decisions will be made as promptly as possible, without compromising the thorough assessment of each application. The Consulate General of Germany is committed to keeping processing times reasonable and efficient.

However, the decision-making process may take up to 15 calendar days after the application is deemed admissible. Admissibility is determined by the Consulate on the working day following your submission to VFS Global.

During this period, your passport must remain with the Consulate. However, Cabin Crew and Pilots may request an exemption and receive their passport without the visa decision within three working days from the day after submission to VFS Global.

Cabin Crew and Pilots are required to resubmit their passports within 15 days of receiving them back from VFS Global. Cabin crew and pilots are required to allow a minimum of two working days after resubmitting their passport to VFS, to enable the Consulate to apply the visa decision.

Please note that the granting of the visa, its duration, and the number of entries are at the sole discretion of the Consulate.

The passport can remain at the Consulate General until the visa process is completed (10-15 days).
