

## **Additional documents for minors**

### **NOTARY PERMIT FROM PARENTS FOR THE CHILD'S DEPARTURE ABROAD**

If a minor will travel accompanied by one of the parent (guardian), you should provide original and copy of the notary permit for the child's departure abroad from the second parent or guardian, which will be valid on the territory of all countries of the Schengen agreement. Also you should provide the copy of the foreign passport, copy of the visa, travel tickets and confirmation of co-accommodation of the accompanying person.

In the absence of one parent, you should provide:

- court decision on guardianship;
- in case of death of the second parent - certificate of the death;
- if the parent's location is unknown - certificate from the police.

If the minor child will travel unaccompanied by both of parents, it is necessary to provide his/her foreign passport, as well as notary permit for the child's departure abroad from both parents, in which the responsible person for the minor child in the Schengen countries should be indicated. Also it is necessary to provide the copy of the foreign passport, copy of the visa, the traveler's ticket. When requesting a multiple visa, the validity of the permit should be in accordance with the requested period of validity of the visa.

### **SPONSORSHIP**

Financial document of the parent / guardian paying for the trip, sponsorship letter, first page of the sponsor's national passport, documents confirming the relationship / guardianship (original of the document confirming the availability of regular income as the certificate from the place of work on wages with indication of the position, average monthly income (stamp and signature of the manager should be indicated in the certificate) or the account statement with a sufficient balance for the trip (stamp with bank's details and signature of the bank's employee should be indicated in the statement).
