THE FOLLOWING PERSONS ARE NOT ELIGIBLE FOR TOURIST VISAS:

- Certain professionals require a “Journalist” visa, even though the purpose of travel is Tourism. Employee of the sectors of activity concerned by this requirement are: cinema, television, media, writing, publishing, press, photography, communication and advertising. (This list is non-exhaustive). Please refer to the Journalist Visa checklist.
- Applicants going to India for voluntary work in NGOs or associations should refer to the Employment Visa checklist
- Applicants of Indian origin accompanying parents, spouse of an Indian passport holder or spouse of foreign national holding an OCI/PIO card should apply for an Entry (X) Visa.
- Applicants accompanying parents or spouse holding a Business/Employment Visa should apply for a Business/Employment Dependant Visa.
- Pakistani Nationals should apply for visitor visa

LIST OF DOCUMENTS REQUIRED FOR A TOURIST VISA

- 1 **Original passport valid for a minimum of 6 months (or for the validity requested, if greater) and having at least 2 blank visa pages**
- 2 **Two photographs conforming to Indian Government norms as per specifications mentioned on our website (5 cm * 5 cm)**
 - A Photo service complying to the Indian norms are available in our offices
- 3 **An Indian Government visa application form duly filled in online and signed on pages 1 and 2 (<https://indianvisaonline.gov.in/>)**
[Refugee passport holders should select nationality as ‘STATELESS’].
- 4 **In case applicant is self-employed: copy of company registration ([KVK Business Register extract](#))**
- 5 **[Declaration form](#) : to be filled by all applicants submitting any application**
- 6 **Additional documents mentioned below as per your case**

LIST OF ADDITIONAL DOCUMENTS

If the applicant has previously held Indian nationality (one of the below documents)

- A copy of their “Surrender Certificate” (if you do not have this you may refer to our website for details)
- A copy of their “Renunciation Certificate” (if you do not have this you may refer to our website for details)
- A copy of their “Deemed Surrender Certificate” (if you do not have this you may refer to our website for details)
- Declaration of the status of the Indian passport and Uttreksel showing the date of obtaining foreign nationality

If the applicant is a minor

- Photocopy of the birth certificate or family Uttreksel showing the names of both parents
- Photocopy of an ID proof of each parent
- No Objection certificate for a minor to travel signed by both parents (see Download Form section on our website)

If the applicant is not holding a Dutch passport

- Recent Uttreksel from the gemeente or residence proof in the Netherlands including date of registration in the Netherlands
- Residence card showing the date of registration in the Netherlands
- In case the applicant has not been a resident in the Netherlands for less than 1 year the Telex Form is required (see Download Form section on our website)

If the applicant is having dual nationality

- Declaration of holding a second passport
- A copy of the second passport
- In case there is a valid Indian visa in the second passport both passports must be submitted in order to cancel the existing visa.

If the applicant is in the Armed forces or Police personnel and travelling for tourism

- Letter from the Employer stating Job description and confirming purpose of travel.
