

DOCUMENT CHECK LIST

CONFERENCE VISA

- Passport Valid for a minimum of 180 days with at least two blank pages. (Original required)
- Copy of the passport
- Two recent 50 mm * 50 mm size photographs. Please check the Photo Specification.
- Duly filled & Signed online application form.
- The previous Indian Visa copy.
- A copy of the signed letter of Invitation for the conference from organizer in India.
- If not going on individual capacity then a copy of the letter from the Institution represented outside India (The letter to be addressed to The High Commission of India, London or the respective Consulates)
- The following documents are **mandatory** under conditions : **a)** If applicant is a national of Afghanistan, Pakistan, Iraq, Sudan, foreigners of Pakistani Origin, Stateless persons **OR b)** If applicant is required to visit 'Restricted' or 'Protected' areas in India (Jammu & Kashmir and the North Eastern states(other than states of Manipur, Mizoram and Nagaland)
 - A copy of event clearance from the Ministry of Home Affairs, Government of India.
 - Political clearance from the M/O External Affairs, Government of India.
- Declaration form

Copy of Surrender Certificate and Copy of the Cancelled Indian Passport (Self-Attested) OR

If travelled to India before, please provide your previous Passport with Indian Visa

Important Note:

- Applicants are requested to submit/send the photocopies of the supporting documents (not the originals) unless originals are requested.
- All Applicants should fill the form correctly as per details from their current valid passport.
- UK passport holder need to ensure that they have filled in the nationality correctly – as United Kingdom.
- The Invitation/Supporting letters should be provided on the letter head of the company/ organization with applicants details (Name and passport number) and addressed to High Commission of India and its respective Consulates.
