**Requisite Documents for Family Re-union Visa for Joining Spouse Resident In Italy**

**MANDATORY DOCUMENTS: Please show original documents at the time of submission of Application.**

1.	<b>Application form</b> fully completed and signed by applicant.
2.	<b>Two recent passport-size Photographs of size 3.3 *3.5 cms</b> (white background)
3.	<b>Passport/Travel Document must:</b> a) Have been issued within the previous 10 years, and the validity must not exceed 10 years b) At least have a validity of 3 months after intended stay c) Have at least 2 face to face blank pages (mandatory). d) Be machine readable without observations.
4.	“Nulla Osta” (No Objection Certificate) in original, issued by competent Questura in Italy. Kindly note that the “Nulla Osta” is valid only for a period up to six months from date of issue. The “Nulla Osta” will have to be renewed on expiry.
5.	Discrepancy, if any, in the names of the applicant/s on the “Nulla Osta” and the passport/s, should be corrected to correspond with the name on the passport.
6.	Photocopy of the air ticket (only one way).
7.	Photocopy of the passport (all pages) of the person who has applied for the “Nulla Osta” in Italy. If available, also of the old passport.
8.	Photocopy of the “Permesso di soggiorno” (Permit of stay).
9.	<b>One set photocopy of applicant’s Passport and all previous Schengen, UK &amp; US Visas. And a covering letter from the applicant.</b>
10.	Verification of original documents and of the Italian translation of Birth Certificate, Marriage Certificates, Ration Cards & other relevant documentation. * If any change has occurred in this regard an adequate proof of residence needs to be submitted (Bank account, telephone/electricity bill etc.)
11.	The spouse residing in Italy may produce his/her certificate in Italy and have it attested by the local Italian Authorities (Commune).
12.	Marriage Certificate in original along with translation in Italian both attested by the local Authorities and verified by the Under Secretary, Home Department.
13.	Photocopy of the passport of the spouse in Italy, clearly showing the dates of arrival/departure in India for the celebration of the marriage and the registration of the same.
14.	Applicant must provide all the documents in Two sets (Except Birth Certificate, Marriage certificate, Passports and Affidavits).
15.	Must provide the photocopy of the Verification fee Receipt (Mandatory).
16.	Must provide original Marriage photographs (at least 5 showing the place/venue of the marriage/marriage party solemnization).

\* The Embassy/Consulate reserves the right to request for further documentation and to verify the documentation submitted. In this case the maximum period of 90 days fixed by the Italian law for the evaluation of this visa type will be suspended till verification is completed.
