



MANDATORY DOCUMENTS FOR ACCOMPANYING FAMILY VISA

(FAMILIARE AL SEGUITO)

Passport / Travel Document	a) Have been issued within the previous 10 years, and the validity must not exceed 10 yrs.	
	b) At least have a validity of 3 months from the date of the expiry of the visa.	
	c) Have at least 2 blank pages	
Visa application Form	a) 2 signatures of the applicant (page 3- column 37 and page 4)(Application forms for minors has to be signed by both the parents in both the places)	
	b) 2 photographs to be submitted.	
	c) Travel dates to be mentioned	
	d) Please mention "N/A" wherever columns are blank	
Check list	Tick the documents submitted	
	For a "familiare al seguito" visa the application for the work/research study visa only (ricerca scientifica) and the accompanying family visa must be applied for simultaneously.	
Delega (Link for the Form)	A "Delega" (click here) must be signed before this Consulate General to nominate a person in Italy to apply for and obtain the "Nulla Osta per familiare al seguito" on behalf of the principal applicant. The person to be nominated for the "delega" should be someone in Italy e.g. the sponsor/University/Institute who can apply on behalf of the principal applicant to the competent " <u>Sportello Unico per l'Immigrazione</u> " for the "Nulla Osta al familiare al seguito".	
For Accompanying Spouse in Italy	_ Original Marriage Certificate issued by the Registrar of Marriage, Sub-Registrar, Tehsildar or Grama Panchayat, clearly mentioning the registration number. To be notarised and duly validated by the Under Secretary of the Home Department of the relevant/competent State Government & apostilled by the Ministry of External Affairs/ New Delhi. This Certificate should be translated into the Italian language by a recognized translator. The certificate and the translation should be legalized by this Consulate General.	
For Accompanying minor/s	_ Original Birth Certificate issued by the Registrar of Births & Deaths, Sub-Registrar, Tehsildar or Grama Panchayat,clearly mentioning the registration number. To be notarised and duly validated by the Under Secretary of the Home Department of the relevant/competent State Government & apostilled by the Ministry of External Affairs/ New Delhi. This Certificate should be translated into the Italian language by a recognized translator. The certificate and the translation should be legalized by this Consulate General. Minors traveling with both the parents do not require an affidavit of consent, provided that the names of both parents appear on the said minor's passport	

One and the same certificate	Original and photocopy to be collected, in case of any discrepancy in names. This has to be issued by the competent Tehsildar or Grama Panchayat, notarised, legalised by Home Department, apostilled by the Ministry of External Affairs/New Delhi and translated into the Italian language. The translation should be legalised by the Consulate General. All names & personal details must correspond on the nulla osta, passport and birth/marriage certificates.	
	_ Original certificates to be duly validated by the Under Secretary of the Home Department of the relevant/competent State Government and apostilled by the Ministry of External Affairs/New Delhi. This Certificate should be translated into the Italian language by a recognized translator. The certificate and the translation should be legalized by the Consular section of this Consulate General.	
Passport copy of the applicant and principal applicant who will work/study in Italy.	. Photocopy. Passport copies required of both parents in case of minors accompanying parents. Photocopy of all observations in the passport	
Air ticket	Reservation printout of one way ticket.	

FOR INDIAN SPOUSE OF ITALIAN/EU/SEE CITIZENS

Dichiarazione per “familiare al seguito” ovvero per “ricongiungimento familiare” (Link for the Form)	A declaration must be signed in front of the Consulate General, with a copy of the identity document, requesting the presence of the spouse in Italy and which attests that he/she shall be economically dependent on the principal applicant.	
Transcription of marriage.	To be done through the Consular Section by submitting the original Marriage Certificate issued by the Registrar of Marriages, Sub-Registrar, Tehsildar or Grama Panchayat, clearly mentioning the registration number. To be notarised and duly validated by the Under Secretary of the Home Department of the relevant/competent State Government & apostilled by the Ministry of External Affairs/ New Delhi.	
One and the same certificate	Original and photocopy to be collected, in case of any discrepancy in names. This has to be issued by the competent Tehsildar or Grama Panchayat, notarised, legalised by Home Department and apostilled by the Ministry of External Affairs/New Delhi. All names must correspond on the passport and birth/marriage certificates.	

Passport copy of the applicant and principal applicant.	Photocopy. Passport copies required of both parents in case of minors accompanying parents. Photocopy of all observations in the passport	
Air ticket	Reservation printout of one way ticket.
