NATIONAL'S SPOUSE – FAMILY REUNION VISA**

<b>MANDATORY DOCUMENTS: Please show original documents at the time of submission of Application.</b>	
<b>1.</b>	<b>Application form</b> fully completed and signed by applicant
<b>2.</b>	<b>One recent passport-size</b> photograph (white background)
<b>3.</b>	<b>Passport/Travel Document must:</b> a) Have been issued within the previous 10 years, and the validity must not exceed 10 yrs. b) At least have a validity of 3 months after intended stay. c) Have at least 2 blank pages.
<b>4.</b>	<b>One set photocopy of applicant's Passport.</b>
<b>5.</b>	Passport copy of the EU / Italian national
<b>6.</b>	Certificate of citizenship of the EU / Italian national (if naturalized) inviting the Indian step son/daughter
<b>7.</b>	Marriage certificate of the EU / Italian National issued by the competent Italian Municipality (upto 6 months old from the date of issuance)
<b>8.</b>	Duly apostilled birth certificate of the step son/daughter, issued by the competent Authorities in the country of birth, in which the name of both parents is mentioned
<b>9.</b>	If applicant is above 21 years of age, last 1 year money transfer receipts from Italy to India in favor of step son/daughter (bank transfers receipts, moneygram/western union receipts etc..) or documented proof that the step son/daughter is a student and not employed
<b>10.</b>	If applicant is minor (below 18 years of age), consent letter (in the form of Affidavit) from the biological parents, along with their ID copy, giving their consent to the child travelling to Italy for tourism, or consent letter from the guardian along with ID copy if both parents are abroad
<b>11.</b>	Residential Certificate of the EU/Italian national issued by the competent Italian Municipality (upto 6 months old from the date of issuance)
<b>12.</b>	Invitation letter from the EU / Italian national (upto 6 months old from the date of issuance)
<b>13.</b>	If biological parents are divorced, duly apostilled Divorce Deed
<b>14.</b>	If one of the biological parent is expired, duly apostilled Death certificate

**NOTE: Visa fees are not applicable. This Embassy reserves the right to ask for a Personal Interview or Additional Documents, whether required.**
