**REQUISITE DOCUMENTS FOR SON/DAUGHTER OF EU/ITALIAN
NATIONAL – FAMILY REUNION VISA**

MANDATORY DOCUMENTS: Please show original documents at the time of submission of Application.	
1.	Application form fully completed and signed by applicant
2.	One recent passport-size photograph (white background)
3.	Passport/Travel Document must: a) Have been issued within the previous 10 years, and the validity must not exceed 10 yrs. b) At least have a validity of 3 months after intended stay. c) Have at least 2 blank pages.
4.	One set photocopy of applicant's Passport.
5.	Passport copy of the EU/Italian national
6.	Certificate of citizenship of the EU / Italian national (if naturalized) inviting the son/daughter
7.	Duly apostilled birth certificate of the son/daughter, issued by the competent Authorities in the country of birth, in which the name of both parents is mentioned
8.	If applicant is minor (below 18 years of age), consent letter (in the form of Affidavit) from the biological parent in India, along with his/her ID copy, giving his/her consent to the child travelling to Italy for family reunion with the biological parent residing in Italy, or consent letter from the guardian along with ID copy if both parents are abroad
9.	If applicant is above 21 years of age, last 1 year money transfer receipts from Italy to India in favor of the son/daughter (bank transfers receipts, moneygram/western union receipts etc..) or documented proof that the son/daughter is a student and not employed
10.	Residential Certificate of the EU/Italian national issued by the competent Italian Municipality (upto 6 months old from the date of issuance)
11.	"Family register" certificate (Certificato di Stato Famiglia) of the EU / Italian national issued by the competent Italian Municipality (upto 6 months old from the date of issuance)
12.	Invitation letter from the EU / Italian national along with consent letter to the child travelling to Italy (upto 6 months old from the date of issuance)

NOTE: Visa fees are not applicable. This Embassy reserves the right to ask for a Personal Interview or Additional Documents, whether required.
