### FAMILY EU REUNION D VISA

(Spouse/Registered partnership/ descendants under 21, dependent parents and descendants, dependent in-laws.)

1.	Visa application form
2.	A valid passport <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Have been issued within the previous 10 years, and the validity must not exceed 10 years.</li><li>• With at least 2 years of residual validity.</li><li>• Your passport or travel document must have at least 2 empty visa pages.</li></ul>
3.	Passport copy of the Italian national
4.	Invitation letter from the EU/Italian national (issued no more than 6 months before the submission of the visa application) stating the intention to reunite with the family member.
5.	<p><b>Proof of the family relationship</b></p> <p>Birth Certificate, Marriage Certificate, Stato civile e Stato di famiglia <b><u>are mandatory.</u></b></p> <p><b><u>CERTIFICATES NEED TO BE REQUESTED ONLINE ON THE ITALIAN ANPR PORTAL, WITH QR CODE.</u></b> If you are a citizen of another European Union country, eIDAS allows you to access the online services of the Italian Public Administration with the digital identity of your country.</p> <p><b><u>Certificates issued by the Italian Municipality will be verified by the Embassy with the competent Authority in Italy.</u></b></p> <p><u>When submitting documents both original Italian (or EU) and Indian documentation need to be provided, and the latter should be duly apostilled.</u></p> <p><b>FOR MINORS APPLYING:</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>a) If applicant is traveling with both parents: original and copy of birth certificate.</li><li>b) If applicant is travelling with one of the parents: original consent letter written and signed by the other parent, legalized through the Italian Embassy/Consulate/Municipality where the other parent is resident and minor applicant's birth certificate (copy and original).</li><li>c) If the minor is travelling alone, both parents will be summoned to the Embassy to sign the consent letter.</li><li>d) If one of the parents passed away, death certificate (original and copy).</li></ul>
6.	Flight Reservation or a statement indicating the start date of the visa validity

7.	Dependent family members are required to present documentary evidence that <b>over the last 12 months</b> the EU citizen has transferred money or born expenses in a quantity that the effective financial dependence can be assessed. Evidence may be adduced by any appropriate means as long as the dependency is genuine and structural in character.
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**Italian citizens residing under Delhi jurisdiction (*Union Territories of Delhi and Chandigarh; the States of Haryana, Punjab, Rajasthan, Jammu-Kashmir, Himachal Pradesh, Uttarakhand and Uttar Pradesh*) and regularly enrolled in the Consular Register may contact the Consulate of Italy in Delhi to retrieve the necessary documentation.**

**NOTE: VISA FEES ARE NOT APPLICABLE. THIS EMBASSY RESERVES THE RIGHT TO ASK FOR A PERSONAL INTERVIEW OR ADDITIONAL DOCUMENTS, WHETHER REQUIRED. ALL THE DOCUMENTS SHOULD BE PROVIDED IN ORIGINAL AND COPY. ANY FORGED OR FAKE CERTIFICATE/AFFIDAVIT/PASSPORT SUBMITTED WILL NOT BE RETURNED TO THE APPLICANT WHO MIGHT BE PROSECUTED IN BOTH THE ITALIAN AND THE INDIAN COURTS.**
