REQUISITE DOCUMENTS FOR A RE-ENTRY VISA.

Note:- Type of visa foreseen for foreign citizens legally residing in Italy but momentarily without a valid Italian residence permit (lost or stolen or expired since less than 60 days and whose renewal has been requested within the appointed time-frame) who intend to re-enter Italy.

1.	Application form fully completed and signed by applicant
2.	One recent passport-size photograph (white background)
3.	Passport/Travel Document must: a) Have been issued within the previous 10 years, and the validity must not exceed 10 yrs. b) At least have a validity of 3 months after intended stay. c) Have at least 2 blank pages.
4.	Copy of residence permit (<i>permesso di soggiorno</i>).
5.	One set photocopy of applicant's current passport.
6.	Valid air ticket.
7.	Covering letter by the applicant detailing the reasons for re-entry visa application.
8.	In case the applicant has applied for renewal of residence permit (<i>permesso di soggiorno</i>), he/she must submit copy of renewal receipt.
9.	In case of lost or stolen residence permit, original F.I.R. from the competent local Police Authorities.
10.	In case the applicant's stay outside the Italian territory has prolonged beyond the period foreseen by the current regulations, or has not renewed the residence permit on time, he/she must provide documental proof to justify the same (e.g.: for medical condition, certificate stating the illness and duration of treatment is mandatory).
10.	In case: a) the applicant was previously residing in Italy for family reasons, he/she must also provide copy of his/her residence permit and passport copy of the spouse/son/daughter/parent living in Italy, accompanied by the relevant invitation letter; b) the applicant was previously staying in Italy for work, he/she must provide a fresh letter from the employer requesting the issuance of re-entry visa in favour of the applicant, mentioning the reason for his/her presence in Italy.

NOTE: This Embassy reserves the right to ask for a personal interview or additional documents
