Requisite documents for Re-Entry

1.	National (“D”-Type) visa application form
2.	A valid passport + 1 copy <ul style="list-style-type: none">Your passport or travel document must be valid for at least 3 months from the date on which you will leave the Schengen area.Your passport or travel document must have at least 2 empty visa pages.
3.	Copy of residence permit
4.	In case the Italian residence permit (“Permesso di soggiorno”) was stolen or lost: <u>Original police report</u> issued by the relevant police authorities of the country where the loss or theft happened. Important: it is mandatory to indicate the relevant Questura which has issued the permit. Failing to provide this information it will be not possible to process the application.
5.	In case the applicant has applied for renewal of residence permit: A copy of the renewal receipt must be submitted.
6.	In case: <ul style="list-style-type: none">The applicant has overstayed outside the Italian territory for more than 1 year, orResidence permit expired for more than 60 days and for which renewal has not been requested within the terms it is mandatory to provide documentary evidence to justify the same (e.g., medical certificates)
7.	Applicants who are awaiting the first issuance of their Italian residence permit, or whose residence document has been withdrawn by the Questura on the basis of a provision <u>subsequently revoked</u> (e.g., by order of the Judicial Authority) Are eligible to apply for Re-entry visa by providing a copy of the residence permit postal receipt and, if any, a copy of the provision issued by the Italian Authority.
8.	In case the unlimited Italian Residence permit expired for more than 60 days and whose renewal has been requested within the terms, if the applicant had to leave Italy in order to fulfill military obligations: <u>It is compulsory to submit a declaration of the period during which military obligations have been fulfilled issued by the relevant local Authorities</u>
9.	Flight ticket

Visa will be issued **ONLY** after the Embassy receives the no-impediment to proceed by Italian Immigration Authorities (Questura). It is not possible to speed up the processing time.
