1)	Application Form <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Completed visa application signed by the applicant; Applications of minors must be signed by both parents. 			
2)	Two recent passport-size colored photographs <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Full face on white background, one photo attached to application. 			
3)	Current Passport and Previous passports (if any) <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Passport must have at least two blank pages; Passport must be valid for a period of at least 3 months after the date of departure; Copy of current and previous Passport bio-data page. 			
4)	Letter of Invitation/Declaration for “Familiare al Seguito” <ul style="list-style-type: none"> To be completed by Italian/EU national according to Italian Immigration regulations; To be accompanied by a copy of the Italian/EU national’s passport and Identity card. 			
5)	Confirmed Flight Ticket Reservation issued by an airline or travel agency			
6)	Family bond Proof <ul style="list-style-type: none"> FOR SPOUSE: Recent (no older than 3 months) copy of Marriage Certificate (estratto di atto di matrimonio) issued by the relevant Italian Municipality The Marriage Certificate, translated into both English and Italian and duly certified by either the Embassy of Italy in Colombo or, for non-Sri Lankan nationals, by the respective Embassy/High Commission/Consulate situated in Colombo, should be submitted beforehand to the Italian Embassy in Colombo for legalization. The marriage certificate must later on be registered in Italy in order to be valid. FOR CHILD SPONSORED BY PARENT / PARENT SPONSORED BY CHILD BIRTH CERTIFICATE In both cases, the birth certificate of the child is mandatory. Sri Lankan birth certificates must be translated into both English and Italian, certified, and legalized by the Embassy of Italy in Colombo. If that’s the case (i.e. child born in Italy or son/daughter Italian citizen), the applicant should submit a copy of the Italian Birth Certificate. 			

Please note:

- The Embassy reserves the right to request further documentation if and when required;
- All documents should be provided in original accompanied with a set of photocopies in A4 size;
- Documents in Sinhalese, Tamil or any other language must be presented with an official English or Italian translation and must be legalized by the Embassy of Italy in Colombo. In case of non-Sri Lankan nationals, documents must be certified by the respective Embassy / High Commission / Consulate based in Colombo.
