

For Minors Applying for a Visa

1. If the visa applicant is a minor and plans to travel without parents

If a visa applicant is a minor and plans to travel without parents, the following documents are required in addition to the basic visa application requirements.

- Letter of consent signed by a parent
- Document(s) proving the relationship between the applicant and the parent (e.g. birth certificate)
- Photocopy of the parent's valid ID with signature (e.g. driver's license, NIN, etc.). Government issued ID only. Company ID/Organization ID is not acceptable)

2. For Sports and School trips

In addition to the above requirements, a **Certificate of Clearance from the National Agency for the Prohibition of Trafficking in Person (NAPTIP)** is required to apply for a visa for the categories below.

- A minor visa applicant who plans to travel without parents for a sports or school trip (for a stay of up to 90 days).
- A minor student athlete for a long-term stay
