

Airport transit visa valid for transit through the international transit areas of one or more airports of the Schengen Member States

Checklist-Airport transit

1	<p>Visa application form duly completed in Latin characters using the Electronic Visa Application Form https://visa.vrm.lt/epm/, printed and signed by the applicant.</p>	
2	<p>Passport - its validity shall extend at least 3 months after the intended date of departure from the Schengen territory; - it shall contain at least 2 blank pages; - it shall have been issued within the previous 10 years.</p>	
3	<p>One colour photograph 35x45 mm with white background, no older than 6 months.</p>	
	Supporting documents	
4	<p>Proof of residence or legal stay in Japan, if applicable A residence card (在留カード), which validity shall extend at least 3 months after the intended date of departure from the Schengen territory, or a document confirming legal stay in Japan.</p>	
5	<p>Travel medical insurance - covering any expenses which might arise in connection with repatriation for medical reasons, urgent medical attention and/or emergency hospital treatment or death, during applicant's stay on the territory of the Member States; - valid throughout the territory of the Member States and cover the entire period of the person's intended stay; - the minimum coverage shall be EUR 30 000. - Travel insurance should be issued either in Japan or in Schengen member state.</p>	
6	<p>Documents in relation to the onward journey to the final destination after the intended airport transit, such as - flight tickets - visa or other entry permit for the third country of destination, if applicable</p>	
7	<p>If the applicant is a minor: - Birth Certificate or other legal document showing the relationship between the applicant and parents or legal guardians - Copy of parent(s) or legal guardian's passports If travelling with one parent: written consent certified by public notary of the other parent or legal guardian, except in cases of a parent having sole custody or guardianship of the minor; If travels alone (without parents): written consent, certified by public notary, of both parents or legal guardians</p>	

PLEASE NOTE:

The applicant has to provide copies of all documents which cannot remain with the Embassy (e.g. passport, residence card, bank book, etc.)

Supporting documents that are not in English or Lithuanian must be accompanied by a translation. Embassy of Lithuania in Japan may request additional supporting documents at any time.
