

National multiple-entry visa

A student admitted to a higher education institution registered and operating in Lithuania

Checklist

1	Visa application form Duly completed in Latin characters using the Electronic Visa Application Form https://visa.vrm.lt/epm/ , printed and signed by the applicant.	
2	Passport (original and copy of ID page): - valid at least three (3) months after the intended date of departure from the Schengen territory; - containing at least two (2) blank pages; - issued within the previous ten (10) years.	
3	One colour photograph 35×45 mm with light colour background, no older than 6 months.	
Supporting documents		
4	Proof of residence status or legal stay in Japan (original and copy) for non-Japanese citizens only. A residence card (在留カード) valid at least three (3) months after the intended date of departure from the Schengen territory or any other document confirming legal stay in Japan.	
5	The number of mediation letter _____, submitted electronically by Lithuanian higher education institution through the Information System of Public Services https://epis.vrm.lt/epis . The applicant should indicate the number of mediation letter upon arrival at the Visa Application Centre. The mediation letter should be issued no more than 30 days before the submission of application for a national visa.	
6	Proof of financial means (original and copy): A document certifying that an applicant has sufficient funds (e.g. a statement from a bank account) or (and) receives regular income (e.g. a scholarship confirming document) for: - subsistence in Lithuania (sufficient means for livelihood is 0,5 minimum monthly salary - 304 EUR for one month); - return to the country of origin or foreign country to which he/ she is entitled to travel (sufficient amount of return funds is one (1) minimum monthly salary - 607 EUR)	

PLEASE NOTE:

The applicant has to provide copies of all documents which cannot remain with the Embassy (e.g. passport, residence card, bank book).

If only copies of supporting documents provided, their authenticity must be attested by an authorised person or institution.

Supporting documents that are not in English or Lithuanian must be accompanied by a translation.

Embassy of Lithuania in Japan may request additional supporting documents at any time.
