



## Malta

### Study (Short stay) Visa

#### Documents Required

1. <b>The original and photocopy of passport</b> which is valid for at least 3 months prior to departure, should be presented. The passport must have at least two blank pages.	
2. <b>Completed and signed visa application form</b> duly filled in English, together with one recent passport-sized photo.	
3. <b>Qatar residency</b> with a validity period beyond the duration of the entire study course <b>plus three months</b> .	
4. <b>Proof of sufficient financial means</b> equivalent to 75% of the national minimum wage for every month of study; (Minimum wage in Malta as per 2025 is Euro961 per month)	
5. <b>Air ticket/s</b> to the final destination with the return trip, where applicable.	
6. <b>Host/hotel confirmation</b> for the duration of the course. <b>Cost of accommodation must be indicated.</b> If the applicant is being host or accommodation paid for by a third party in Malta <b>an original signed, stamped and notarized Declaration of Proof</b> is to be provided.	
7. <b>Travel medical insurance with a minimum coverage of €30,000. This is in addition to the medical/health insurance required for the duration of the stay.</b>	
8. <b>Letter of sponsorship</b> , including a copy of the identification document and contact details of sponsor/s, if the applicant is sponsored by a third party.	
9. <b>Proof of scholarship</b> , if applicable	
10. <b>Students who are not pursuing a higher-education qualification</b> must provide an enrolment/ acceptance letter from a local education institution licensed by the national regulator. For courses below MQF level 5, the documentation must include a confirmation that the student will be covering a minimum of 15 contact hours per week, a copy of the time table and a schedule of lessons per every month of study.	
11. <b>Students who are pursuing a higher-education</b> qualification must provide an <b>enrolment / acceptance letter from a local education institution</b> licensed by the national regulator. The document must include a confirmation that 60 European Credit Transfer System (ECTS) are obtained within a maximum period of one year. The same proportion will be applied for other credit systems. These students also have to present evidence of the times table and a schedule of lessons per every month of study.	
12. <b>Proof of sufficient language proficiency</b> to be eligible to apply for the selected course of study.	
13. <b>Full-refund medical health insurance</b> from a recognised provider covering the entire duration of the course. The policy must cover the entire duration of the course and not the duration of the visa originally issued to the applicant;	
14. <b>In case of minors:</b>	
<b>A.</b> Birth certificate /family book	
<b>B.</b> Passport data page of both parents or legal guardians	
<b>C.</b> Authorisation of the two parents or legal guardians, the authorisation document has to be duly authenticated. In case of any doubts the Consul may always request further information or documents;	
15. <b>Proof of payment received by the education institution</b> related to the applicant's course:	
<b>A.</b> For courses of a value of up to €1,000, the receipt covering full payment shall be requested	
<b>B.</b> For courses of a value of more than €1,000 but less than €2,500, the receipt covering up to 75% of the course shall be requested;	
16. For courses of a value that is equal to or higher than €2,500, the receipt covering up to 50% of the course shall be requested;	

17. <b>Erasmus Plus students</b> need to present the Agreement signed by themselves and the Qatar Educational institution which provides the details of the exchange program. They also need to present Confirmation/Agreement Letter from the school in Malta	
18. <b>Any additional documents that may be deemed necessary by the Consular Post.</b>	
19. <b>All documents must be in English.</b>
