VISA APPLICATION FOR **MEDICAL VISIT**

	Duly completed application form (DHA-84) Form 11 filled with black ink .
	Two (2) recent identity photographs in color on a white background.
	Copy of the Yellow Fever Vaccination Record, less than 10 years old. NB: be vaccinated ten (10) days before departure In South Africa.
	A valid passport at least one month after the return date ,with at least two blank pages
	Two (2) copies of the first page (the identity page) of the passport.
	Flight reservation with the details.
	Proof of accommodation: hotel reservation or confirmation of residence (lease agreement in good standing, house bill).
	<u>Proof of the socio-professional and economic situation</u> <u>For traders or entrepreneurs:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none">• NINEA copy and Trade Register.• Bank statements original copies (last 3 months) <u>For the professionals:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none">• Work certificate.• Bank statements original copies (last 3 months). <u>For unemployed applicants (including students)</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none">• letter of support• proof of the resources of the person providing the care in the form of bank statements for the last 03 months + a legalized copy of his passport or national identity card)

	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • A letter of recommendation from a doctor in your country of residence. • A proof of appointment at a public or private hospital in South Africa.
	<p><u>NB: For nationals of ECOWAS member countries:</u> In addition to the above documents, please submit the legalized copy of your consular card</p> <p><u>For all other foreigners:</u> In addition to the above mentioned documents, please submit a legalized copy of the authorization receipt in Senegal.</p>
	<p>For minors:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • if the child is traveling with both parents: they must simply bring the original copy of their child's birth certificate • If the child is traveling with only one parent: affidavit signed by the other parent cf. page 2 of the affidavit for supporting documents. • If the child travels with a third person: affidavit signed by both parents attach supporting documents cf. page 2 of the affidavit <p><u>NB:</u> Please note that the affidavit must imperatively be completed and signed in front of the Consul. And to do this, please make an appointment with the consulate.</p> <p>If one of the parents or parents is abroad, they must contact the authorities of the South African Consulate of their country of residence to have the affidavit signed by the competent authority.</p>
	<p>Visa and services fees.</p>
	<p>Travel insurance covering the stay</p>

NOTE: Some documents from South Africa must be legalized by police in South Africa

You must submit your application in person.

I am informed that an incomplete application and/or a false statement on the above form can delay the process or even result in a refusal by the consulate. I am also informed that VFS must not be opposed to my visa request submitting. However, I am aware that VFS must notify me of the missing of some documents. In consequence, I will have to complete my application for process. And, any breaches in this regard may result in a refusal.

I recognize that I can be convened for an interview by the consulate; if need be. If so, VFS will communicate to me a date for an appointment but free of any additional expenses. If necessary, the consulate can also request supplementary information/documents.

NB: I understand that: the issuance of a visa is left to the full appreciation of the consulate. Obtaining the visa simply indicates that I am eligible to enter South Africa. This visa does not necessarily guarantee a right of automatic access to the South African territory, since the decision of my authorization of entry and the duration of my stay remains the prerogative of the immigration officer at the port of entry to South Africa.
