	2 recent photos, with light background not older than 6 months, full visibility of facial features	
	Travel insurance, covering Schengen area for a minimum of EURO 30'000.00	
	Printout of flight booking or airline ticket	
	Proof of accommodation	
	Attestation from the school / university with program. The letter must mention the student's name and details about the stay	
	Proof of payment of the school fees	
	Bank statement for last 3 months. Older balance sheets are not accepted	
	For applicants under the age of 18 no-objection letter signed by both parents with copies of their passports, residence permits and ID card (if available)	
	Copies of previously obtained Schengen visas

- Original documents must be presented
- The Swiss Embassy reserves the right to ask for additional supporting documentation and may invite the applicant for a personal interview at the Embassy
