



## Checklist for Schengen Visa (type C): Medical

No.	Documents Required All documents should be in English or translated to English	Yes	No
1	<b>Passport: Original with (1 copies), recognized by Switzerland:</b> - Issued within the last 10 years and with at least 3 months validity after the scheduled return, with at least two blank pages. - If the passport does not state the place of birth, a copy of ID card or a birth certificate must be submitted.		
2	<b>Visa application form:</b> - Completed, signed twice by the applicant, if applicable, authorization of third person.  The visa application form is free of charge and can be downloaded from the website: <a href="https://www.sem.admin.ch/sem/en/home/themen/einreise/visumantragsformular.html">https://www.sem.admin.ch/sem/en/home/themen/einreise/visumantragsformular.html</a>		
3	<b>One recent passport-sized photograph</b> with a white background, not stapled. Full face, no head or face cover(s) that prevent(s) full visibility of the facial features.		
4	<b>Travel Insurance:</b> Proof of travel medical insurance covering the entire period of intended stay, valid for all Schengen States and covering any expenses which might arise in connection with repatriation for medical reasons, urgent medical attention, emergency hospital treatment not excluding COVID-19 infections, or death during the stay. The minimum coverage must be EUR 30'000.00. <b>in English</b>		
5	<b>Flight Ticket:</b> Copy of flight reservation/s including details of the itinerary and the flight reservation number. <b>in English</b>		
6	<b>Employment letter:</b> Original letter from employer/sponsor in Saudi Arabia stating employment status, position held, date of recruitment, length of contract and whether renewable or not, as well as salary, attested by the Chamber of Commerce. The letter must include the purpose of the visit and cost coverage guarantee, whether it is covered by the company or by the applicant. <b>in English</b>  <b>If Self-employed:</b> valid original trade license and one copy thereof with English translation.		
7	<b>Financial Means:</b> In addition to the documents regarding health treatment listed above, you will have to submit proof you are capable of covering any other expenses. You can do so through a bank statement (last 3 months). <b>in English</b>		
8	<b>Minors:</b> For minors travelling without their parents/legal guardian: original authorization signed by their parents/legal guardian and copy of passport(s) of parents/legal guardian.		

### Depending on your visa type:

<b>For Medical:</b> Documents confirming applicant's need for health treatment, as: - Certificate from a medical doctor confirming the need of specific medical treatment in Switzerland. - Confirmation from a medical doctor that necessary treatment can be provided by a hospital in Switzerland. - Proof of an appointment made at this hospital. - Proof of advance payment of the treatment.		
Proof of accommodation. - If you are going to stay at a hospital throughout your whole period in Switzerland, you should submit a confirmation by this hospital to prove that. If not, then you should submit either a rental contract, where you will be staying.		

### Additional requirements for: Non – Saudi Nationals:

1	Iqama valid for at least three months after the planned date of return, and one copy thereof. Translated <b>in English</b>		
2	- Copy of <b>Electronic Exit Re-Entry Visa</b> . The visa must be valid beyond the intended date of departure from the territory of the Schengen States <b>in English</b> - <b>Muqem</b> print <b>in English</b> - <b>GOSI</b> print <b>in English</b>		
3	Bank statements (showing the regular monthly income/salary) for the past six months. <b>in English</b>		

***Personal appearance of the applicant is mandatory to submit a visa application, if the fingerprints have not been captured during the last 59 months. If the fingerprints have been captured during the last 59 months, the application can be sent through a representative***

#### **General Information:**

The Embassy of Switzerland in Saudi-Arabia have outsourced the application process for short-term visas (so called Schengen visas) to the external service provider VFS Global

Our external service provider will support you during the application process. VFS Global is responsible for receiving your visa application, checking the completeness and acceptability of your application form and application documents, collecting biometric data, receiving the visa fee and other fees (service fee and optional fees) and returning your passport. The decision whether or not to issue a visa is taken by the Swiss Embassy only, VFS Global is not involved in the decision.

#### **When should you place your visa application?**

It is recommended to place your visa application 6 weeks prior to your intended travel date. Please be aware that it is possible to place your visa application 6 months before your intended trip and at the most 15 days before your planned arrival date to the Schengen area.

#### **How much should you wait before you get an answer?**

You should wait between 10 to 15 days before getting an answer. This period may be longer if you place your application in a busy period (summer vacations and school holidays).

#### **Declaration:**

I have been informed that an application without a complete set of documentation according to the above-mentioned checklist may result in a rejection of my visa application. Besides, the Embassy of Switzerland Riyadh reserves the right to ask for additional supporting documents and may request for personal interview at the embassy.
