<b>1</b>	<b>Travel Documents and Pictures</b>		
1.1	Valid Passport for 1 year from date of entry (with at least 2 empty pages).		
1.2	A complete Visa Application form (must be filled in blue ink/typed) with the original signature of the applicant.		
1.3	Two recent photographs (not older than 3 months) of applicant Size - 3.5x4.5cm, white background & matt finish, with applicant's signature on the back.		
1.4	A photocopy of the return confirmed travel ticket.		
1.5	Cover letter, typed and sign specifying the purpose of travel, travel dates, address in Thailand. Family name and passport number with relation, If applied with family. (Only father, mother, spouse or children are acceptable)		
1.6	Proof of residence in India (for non-Indian passport holders)		
<b>2</b>	<b>Proof of Adequate Finance and Occupation</b>		
	<b>For Individual Tourist</b>		
2.1	Bank statement of six months (must be original and attested by the bank) with equivalent minimum current balance to 500,000 INR maintained throughout six months.		
2.2	Evidence of Employment and regular/monthly income in India including Income Tax Returns, Letter of Employment stating salary, Payment Slips, VAT/Services Tax Registration Certificate, and Business License/Registration where applicable.		
<b>3</b>	<b>Accommodation</b>		
3.1	Proof of Hotel /Accommodation reservation in Thailand with contact number and address.		
3.2	If traveling for long duration, A fully-paid residential lease in Thailand for the whole duration of intended stay in Thailand. The lease must be issued by the lessor showing the duration of stay, and the lessor's contact details and tax ID number		
3.3	A hire-purchase or mortgage agreement of immovable property; OR Condominium title deed		
<b>4</b>	<b>Additional Documents(Mandatory)</b>		
4.1	Criminal Record/ Police Clearance Certificate (verification shall be valid for not more than three months and must be duly notarized)		
4.2	Medical certificate, issued from the country where the application is submitted, showing no prohibitive diseases as indicated in the Ministerial Regulation No.14 (B.E. 2535) (certificate shall be valid for not more than three months and must be duly notarized). 4.3	A copy of valid health insurance certificate cover the whole period of stay in Thailand, Have outpatient benefit in Thailand of not less than 40,000 THB (or 100,000 INR) Have inpatient benefit in Thailand of not less than 400,000 THB (or 1,000,000 INR) Cover all medical expenditures including COVID-19 at least USD 100,000
